

PCO ID Cardholder/ 4 Hour Core Pesticide Training

What is this training?

This training provides basic information on pesticide handling and safety. It includes hands on activities, demonstrations, and case studies for an interactive approach to training in applying pesticides correctly.

Who should attend this training?

This training satisfies the 4 hours of Core training for renewal of all Chapter 487, Bureau of Compliance Monitoring pesticide licenses including but not limited to: Private, O&T, Aquatic, Natural Areas, and ROW.

This training may also be used to satisfy the requirements for license renewal for the Bureau of Entomology Limited licenses, such as: Limited L&O, Limited Structural, and Limited Landscape Maintenance, which is often called the "Roundup license".

This training may also be used to satisfy the requirements for pesticide safety training for PCO ID cardholders in the first year (4hrs) and the following years (2hrs).

PCOs may also use this training to satisfy Core requirements for license renewal.

Anyone needing Core CEUs may attend this training.

Go North on I-75 to I-4. Go East on I-4, take Exit #10 County Road 579 (the next exit). Turn right (South) on CR 579 about ¾ of a mile. Extension Service will be on the left – a low off-white building with dark brown trim.

From the North:

Go South on either I-75 or I-95. Go East on I-4 to County Road 579 (Exit #10). Turn right (Go South) on CR 579 about ¾ of a mile. The Extension Service will be on the left – a low off-white building with dark brown trim.

From the East:

Go West on I-4 to County Road 579 (Exit #10). Turn left (Go South on CR 579 about ¾ of a mile. The Extension Service will be on the left – a low off-white building with dark brown trim.

From the West:

Go East on I-4 past Tampa to County Road 579 (Exit #10). Turn right (Go South) on CR 579 about ¾ of a mile. The Extension Service will be on the left – a low off-white building with dark brown trim.
