

## **Training and Exam or License Renewal: Limited Commercial Landscape Maintenance or Limited L&O**

### **What is this training?**

This training provides the six hours of classroom training and exam legally required for the Limited Commercial Landscape Maintenance (LCM) pesticide applicator's license, which is often referred to as the "Roundup" license, though other pesticides may be applied with this license. Material presented also covers information needed for the Limited Lawn and Ornamental (LLO) exam, which is often requested by government and other landscape maintenance crews, though training is not legally required for this license.

### **Who should attend this training?**

Did you know that according to the State of Florida Statutes, anyone using Roundup or other pesticides in beds and shrubs as part of their business must be licensed or face a **\$5,000 fine** upon inspection? Keep your operation legal by getting this license!

### **What do I need to do to take the exam?**

Register for class online or use the form on back. See the appropriate state application using the above links. Download the application. Fill it out, attach your picture, and bring it to the training. Proof of insurance is also required to get the LCM license (see application). You can also call the Bureau of Entomology at (850) 921- 4177 to have an application sent to you.

**Directions to office**

**From the South:**

Go North on I-75 to I-4. Go East on I-4, take Exit #10 County Road 579 (the next exit). Turn right (South) on CR 579 about 3/4 of a mile. Extension Service will be on the left – a low off-white building with dark brown trim.

**From the North:**

Go South on either I-75 or I-95. Go East on I-4 to County Road 579 (Exit #10). Turn right (Go South) on CR 579 about 3/4 of a mile. The Extension Service will be on the left – a low off-white building with dark brown trim.

**From the East:**

Go West on I-4 to County Road 579 (Exit #10). Turn left (Go South on CR 579 about 3/4 of a mile. The Extension Service will be on the left – a low off-white building with dark brown trim.

**From the West:**

Go East on I-4 past Tampa to County Road 579 (Exit #10). Turn right (Go South) on CR 579 about 3/4 of a mile. The Extension Service will be on the left – a low off-white building with dark brown trim.
